


Q1 Which type of student are you? Check all that apply.








Q4 What is your current field of study? Check all that apply.



Q5 Why did you choose to attend our institution?




Q10 To what extent has the office for veterans facilitated your adjustment to civilian life?




Q14 Have you previously connected with the Office for Disability Services?


